As the landfill fees continue to rise, we want to offer you a solution to dispose of items that would have normally been thrown in the garbage. We are hoping that if we can reduce the amount of pounds that go to the landfill we can continue to keep garbage rates consistent.

### Prepare Your Recyclable Materials

All items must be clean, sorted, separated by material type in separate bins or tied and weighted as not to cause a nuisance.

### We accept the following

#### **Glass:**

Bottles and jars (Rinsed clean. Discard all lids)

*Non acceptable:* light bulbs, drinking glasses, baking dishes, candle jars, Ceramics, window glass, mirrors.

**Plastics:** Containers (Rinsed and Flattened)

*Non acceptable:* Grocery bags, bread bags, furniture wrap, electronics wrap, cereal box liners, plastic toys, laundry baskets, motor oil or antifreeze bottles or Styrofoam.

**Paper:** Newspaper, magazines, copy/typing paper, including colored paper.

*Non acceptable:* Wrapping paper

#### **Cardboard:**

**All cardboard must be broken down flat.**

#### **Tin:**

Tin cans only (Rinsed clean)

*Non acceptable:* Foil, paint cans.

#### ***We Do Not Accept These Items:***

Plastic Bags, Electronics, Cell phones, TV's, Vacuums, Computers, Appliances or Tires.
